DESCRIPTION MODEL A-08

Long, flared skirt with ruffles applied to the bottom.

Original cut that starts from the waist of the front to the bottom of the back.

In the part of the front inside the cut it is inserted the pocket.

Zipper (or invisible) inserted in the back seam.

Fully lined skirt.

VERY IMPORTANT FOR THE REALIZATION OF THE MODEL IS TAKING THE MEASUREMENTS.

In the MEASUREMENTS page, selecting “**Show dummy for measures**”, a dummy is displayed.

Selecting a box for entering measurements, for example Person Height, indicates how to correctly take this height.

Your Measurements must be entered as requested, then it is the TittiCad program which processes them so that the original proportions of the model chosen by you adapt to the your measurements.

THE A-08 MODEL IS COMPOSED OF FOLLOWING PARTS:

N.1 FRONT. Once on the fold of the fabric.

#2 BEHIND. Once on the double fabric.

N.3 RUFFLES IN FRONT. Once on the fold of the fabric

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N.4 RUFFLES BEHIND. Once on the double fabric.

N.5 POCKET BAG. Once on the double fabric.

N.6 POCKET BAG. Once on the double fabric.

Note:

The pattern already includes seam allowances.

MATERIAL REQUIRED FOR THE REALIZATION OF THIS MODEL

The fabric of the model in the photo is pure wool, medium weight.

- Recommended fabric: wool, cotton, jeans.
- Heavy lining.
- An 18 cm zip or invisible zip.
- Sewing machine thread.

PATTERN ON FABRIC AND QUANTITY OF FABRIC NECESSARY

There are 2 possible cases, depending on whether you are using the TittiCad Program (installed on your PC), or the Online Pattern Making Service (present on the website www.titticad.com):

- TittiCad program:

By opening the PRINT page and selecting the **Arrangement on fabric** item from the "List of Available Prints".

a suggestion of how to place the pattern on the fabric is displayed.

- [Online Patterns of www.titticad.com](http://www.titticad.com):

After entering the measurements and requesting the Free Preview, it is shown at the bottom of the page **Arrangement on fabric and required fabric length**.

The vertical arrow indicates the quantity of fabric required, while the horizontal arrow indicates the width of the fabric, it can be double fabric (when 75cm is indicated) or single fabric (when 150cm is indicated).

It is recommended to always take a little more (10-15 cm)

Specific video tutorials for this model

- Sew the back piece together (No.2) along mid back up to the zipper opening.
- Apply the back ruffle (N.4) to the bottom of the back (N.2) and sew. • Join the ruffle at the bottom of the front (N.1). front(No.3) and sew.
- Join the front part with the back part, making sure that the red markers with the same shape coincide, sew by machine omitting the opening for the pocket, indicated in 2 red lines.

- Pack the pocket:

- Apply zipper on the center BEHIND.

- Make the lining in the same way, but without making the pocket.
- Apply the lining to the waist and bottom of the skirt, using suitable techniques.
- Riveting on the obverse with simple stitching on the life.
- On the bottom it is possible to make more parallel riveting between them.
